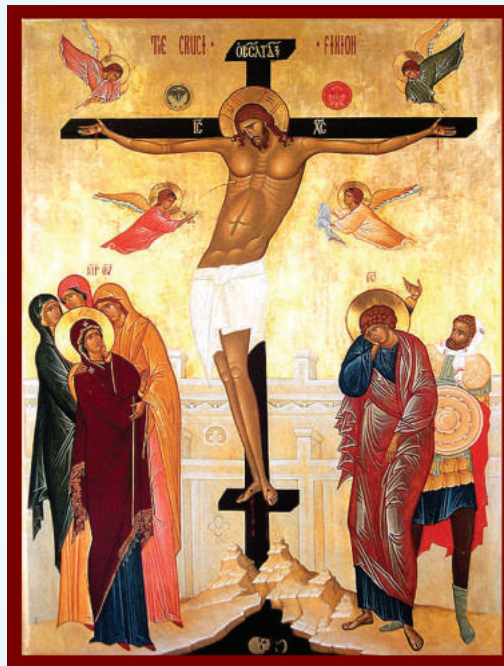

CRUCIFIXION ICON

*“...we preach Christ crucified... the power of God and the wisdom of God” (1Corinthians. 1:23-24)*

This icon shows Christ’s Crucifixion both in the earthly and heavenly realms. At the foot of the Cross stands His grieving Mother, along with St John and one of the Roman centurions. Instead of a crown of thorns, the icon shows a crown of glory on our Lord’s head to remind us that even upon the Cross, Christ is still fully divine. From Christ’s side, the blood and water is collected by an angel with a chalice, reminding us His words “This is My blood of the New Testament, which is shed for many for the remission of sins.”
